Detailed Report:

While on routine patrol at approximately 3:42AM 8/12/75 Officers Killean and Koreski were South bound on West River Street approaching the intersection of West 3rd Street. At the time Officer Koreski was driving and Officer Killean was passenger. The Officers were moving very slow as their attention was attracted to a large dog that was milling around the front of the Mayfair Bar located on the West Side of the street several feet from the intersection.

As the Officers passed the small alley adjacent to the bar Officer Killean yelled "There is someone coming out of the window" and jumped from the vehicle as it came to a stop. The Officers ran West down the alley in pursuit of this man who had jumped from the broken window and was fleeing toward the wooded area to the rear of the tavern. Officer Killean yelled for the man to stop yelling "Stop", "Stop Police" the man ignored this warning and continued to run. Officer Killean then fired two shots from his service revolver and the individual fell to the ground to the rear and slightly to the SouthWest corner of the tavern.

The Officers then radioed this information to the station and Majoras Ambulance service was detailed along with Sgt. Bowen, Ptl. Witt, Ptl. Whitacre.

Sgt Bowen arrived and took charge of the scene directing that the building and area be secured for protection of evidence and for the possibility that there was another individual in the building. Several minutes had passed and the Owner arrived where a check of the tavern showed no other person was inside and information was secured as for a Breaking and entry report. Detective Kristoff was also detailed and arrived at the scene to conduct the investigation of the shooting. Majoras Ambulance Service had arrived and transported the man to the emergency room where he was pronounced D.O.A. At this time it was learned that this man was known as Daryl Maxwell and his family was notified at this time of the incident.
