

Accepts Death Settlement

ELYRIA, Ohio (AP) — Zora Maxwell, whose son, Daryl, was shot to death by an Elyria policeman, has accepted \$17,500 in an out-of-court settlement of her wrongful death suit against Elyria city officials.

Mrs. Maxwell had asked \$2 million in her U.S. District Court suit.

The shooting of Daryl, a

black, in 1975 sparked three days of racial disturbances during which the Highway Patrol had to be called to back up city police.

The death had been ruled justifiable homicide. Police said Patrolman Michael Killeen shot Maxwell during a suspected burglary of a bar.
